IMAGINE YOUR STREET

What do you see?

When you walk out of your front door, what is the first place you see? Is it a place to buy bread, or maybe a place full of books?

Our **neighborhood** is the area around our home where we live, shop, and play.

Fun fact

In many Turkish neighborhoods, the local bakery (firin) is the busiest place early in the morning!



OUR IMPORTANT PLACES

Let's learn the names of the places we visit every day.



The Bakery - Buy fresh bread, simit, and cookies.

The Pharmacy - Get medicine when you feel sick.



The Library - A quiet place to borrow and read books.

WHO WORKS THERE?



Places are full of people who help us!

- At the **bakery**, the **baker** makes bread.
- At the **pharmacy**, the **pharmacist** gives medicine.
- At the **library**, the **librarian** helps find books.

FINDING OUR WAY

Where is it?

To describe a map, we use **prepositions**. These help us tell people exactly where a building is located.

- **In front of:** The park is *in front of* the school.
- **Behind:** The playground is *behind* the library.



LET'S PRACTICE DIRECTIONS

Preposition: Behind

Look at the image. The car is parked **behind** the bakery. It is at the back of the building.




Preposition: In front of

There is a bench **in front of** the library. It is at the entrance where everyone can see it.
