

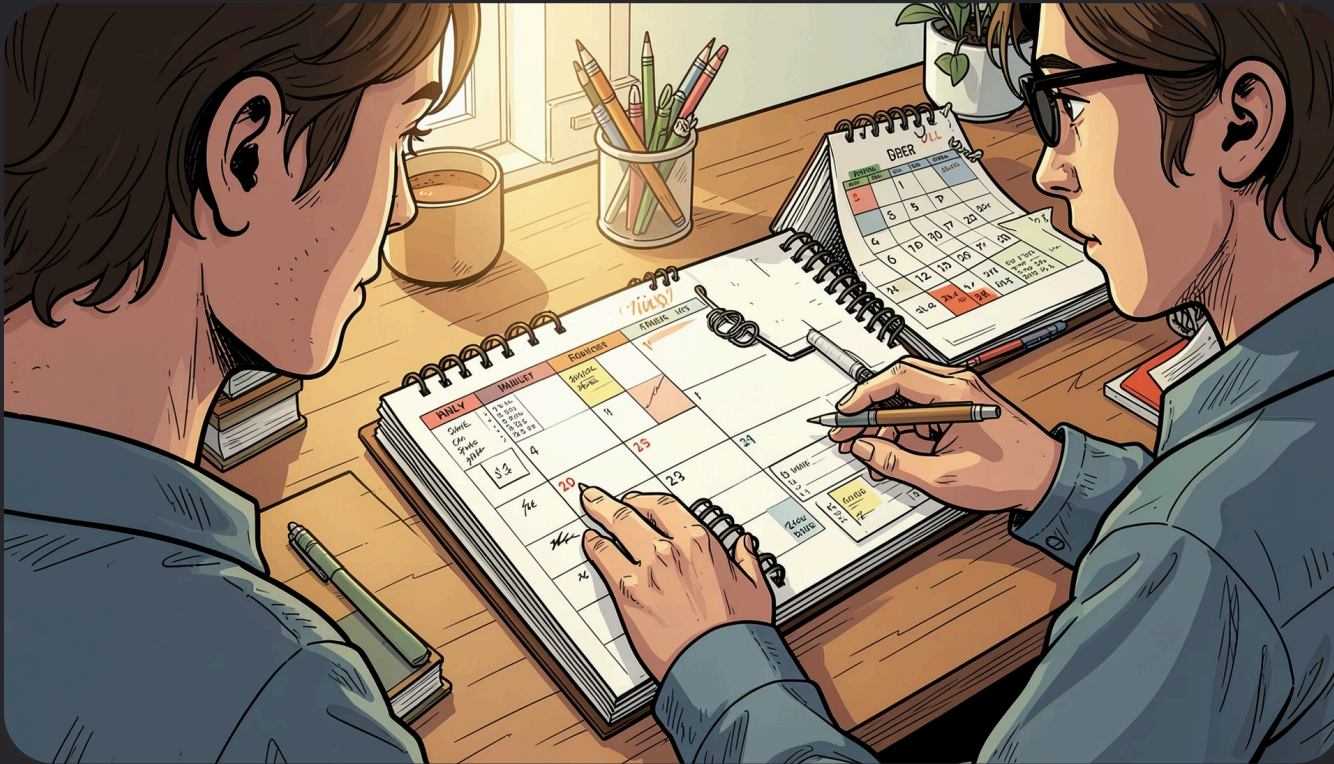

What is the Simple Present Tense?



Daily Habits

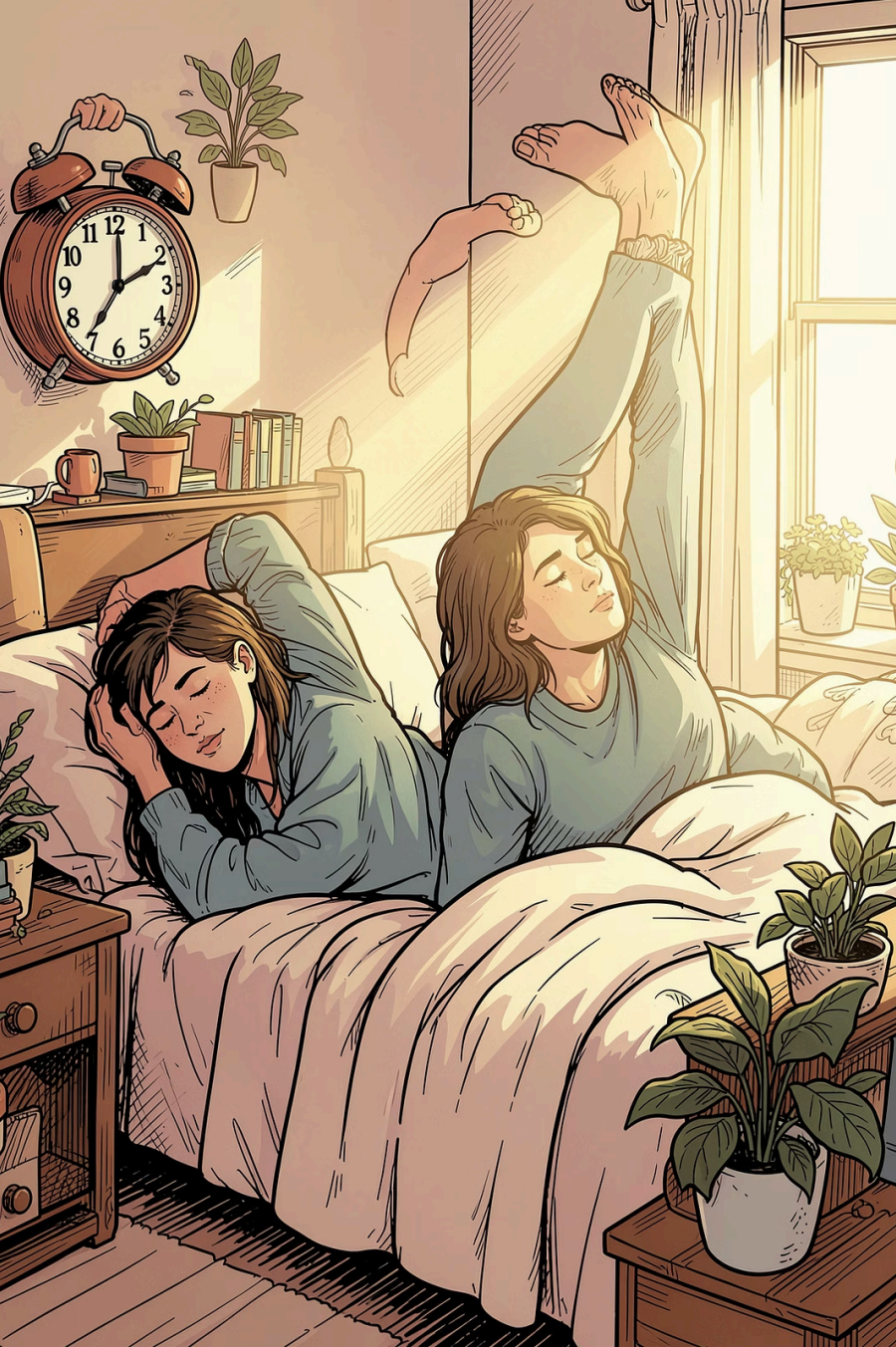
Things you do **every day** or **regularly**.

Facts

Things that are **always true**.

Routines

Things you do at the **same time** each day.



I wake up at 7 AM.

With **I**, **You**, **We**, and **They** — the verb stays the same. No extra letters!

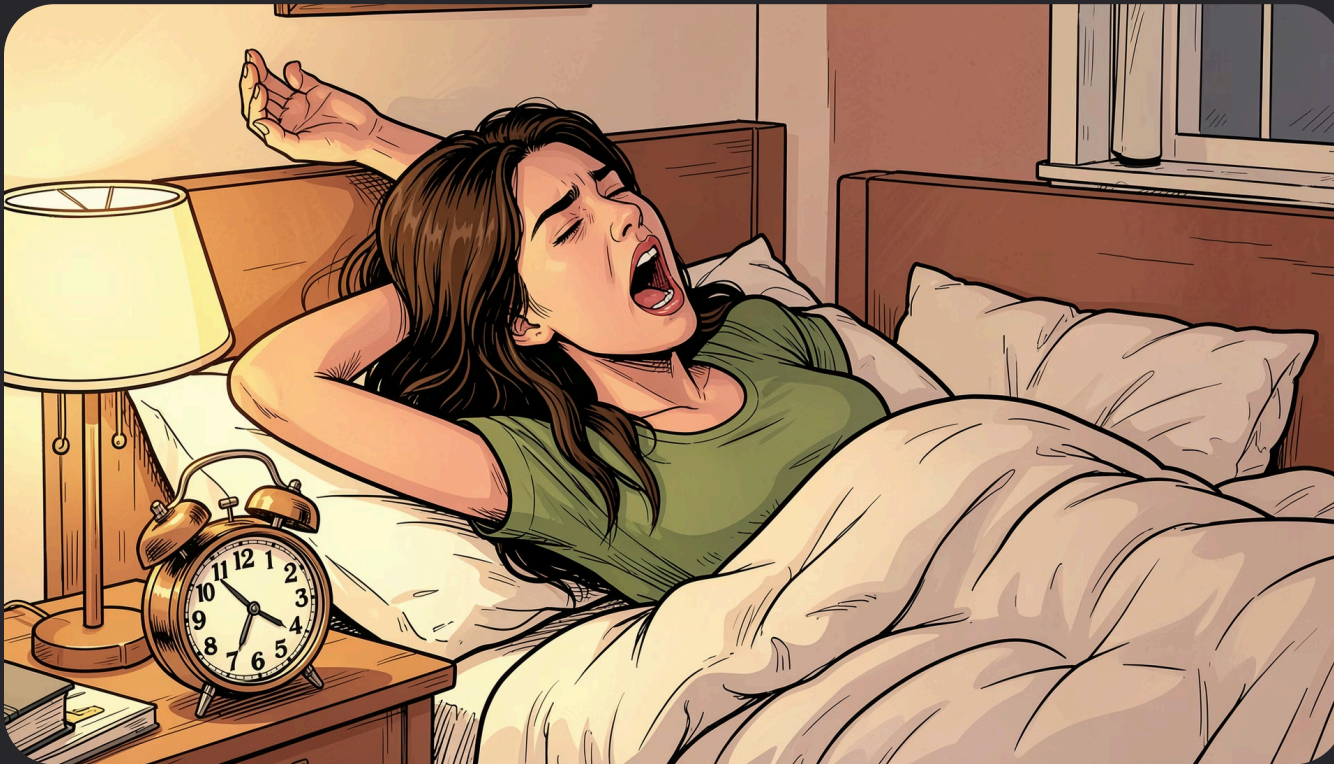
I wake up

You wake up

We wake up

They wake up

He / She / It wakes up at 7 AM.



With **He**, **She**, and **It** — add **-s** to the verb!

He wakes up

She wakes up

It wakes up

⚠ **Remember the 's'!** This is the most important rule in Simple Present.

Do you play an instrument?

Yes

Yes, I **play** the guitar.

No

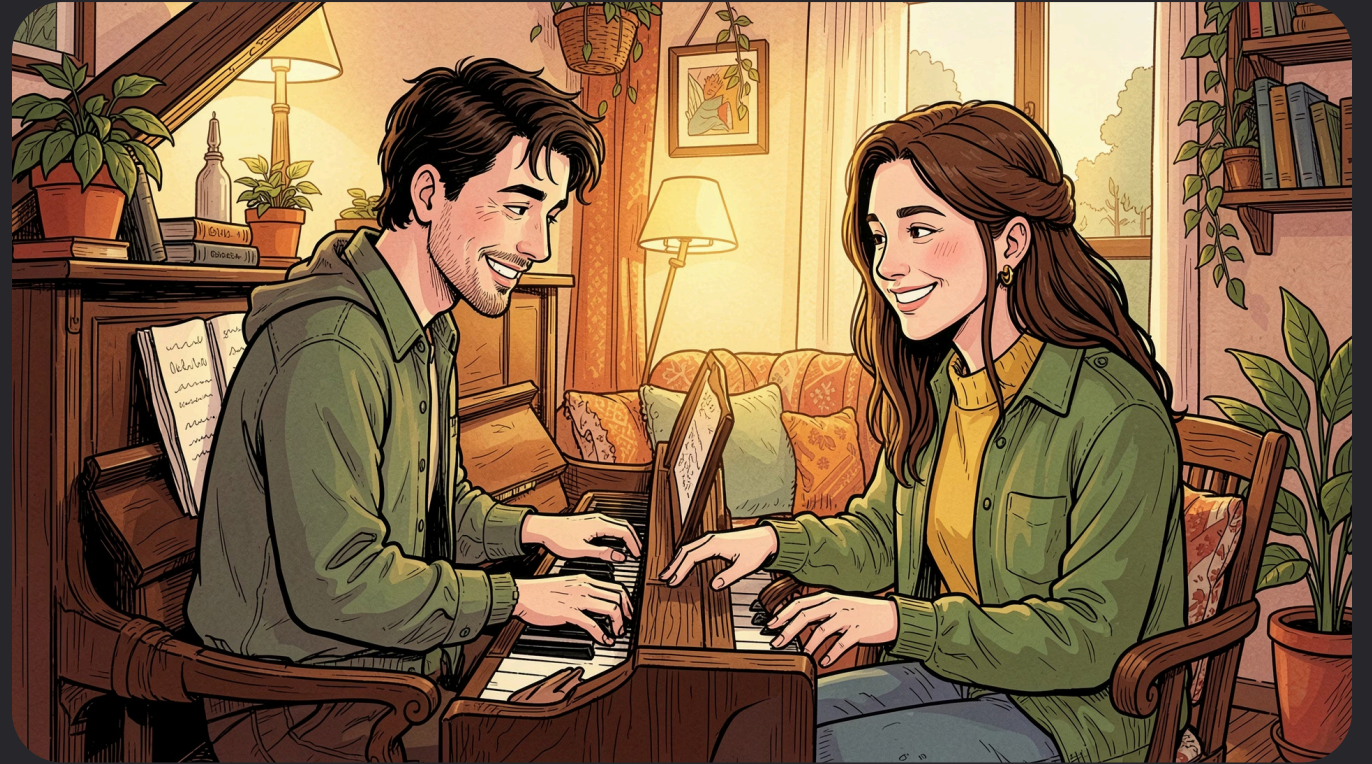
No, I **don't** play an instrument.

Use **Do** for questions with **I, You, We,** and **They.**



Does your friend play an instrument?

Use **Does** for questions with **He**, **She**, and **It**. The verb **does not** add **-s** in the question!



✓ Yes

Yes, he **plays** the piano.

✗ No

No, she **doesn't** play an instrument.



What is your favourite food?

I like pizza.

Use **like** to say what you enjoy.

I love pasta.

Use **love** for something you enjoy a lot.

She loves sushi.

Remember the **-s** with He / She / It!



Do you sing in the shower?



Ask about fun habits! Use **Do** for I / You / We / They.

Yes!

Yes, I **sing** in the shower!

No

No, I **don't** sing in the shower.

Do you speak English every day?

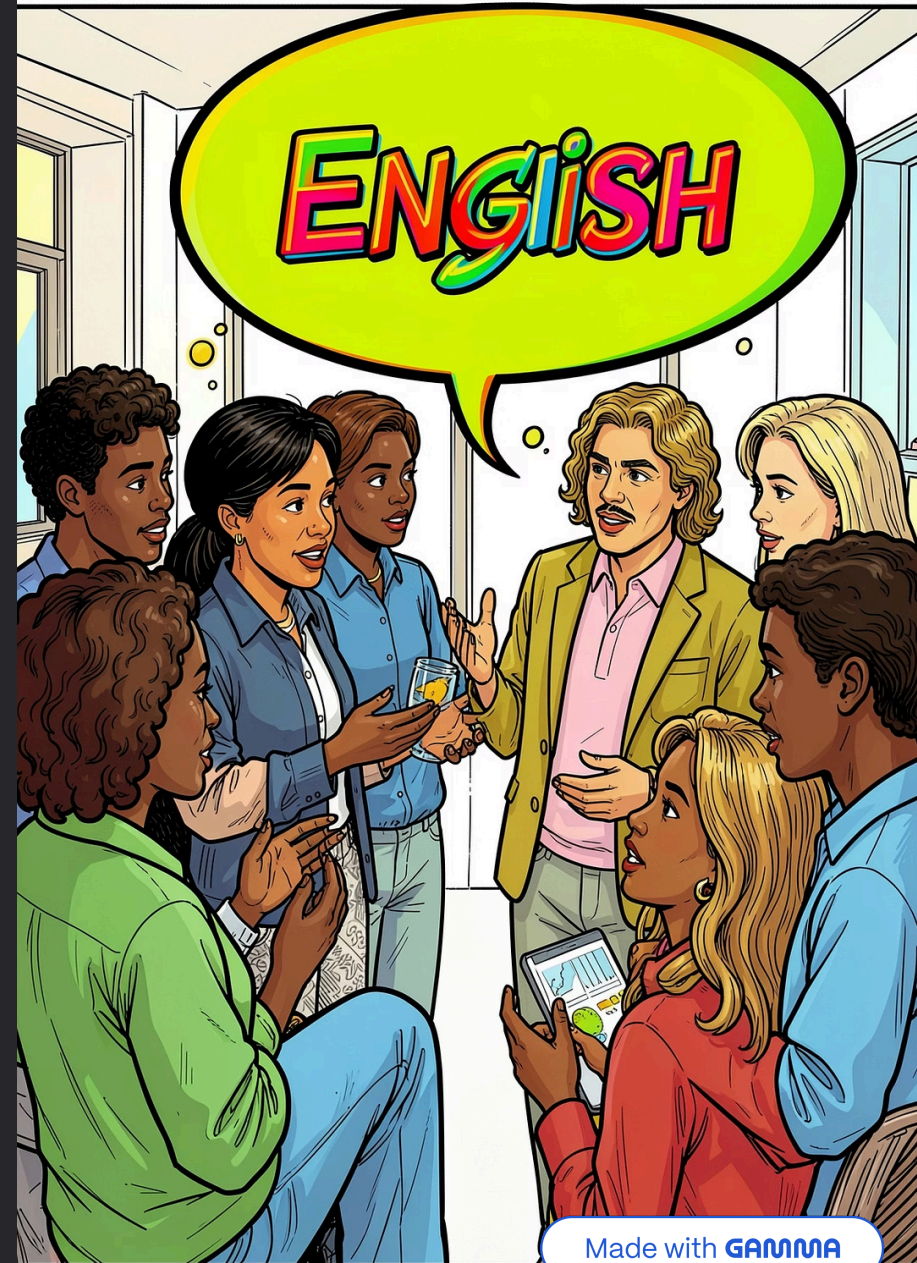
✓ Yes

Yes, I speak English every day.

✗ No

No, I don't speak English every day.

i Key rule: Use **Do** for I / You / We / They. Use **Does** for He / She / It.
