How do we use it?

- **I / You / We / They** → verb stays regular (e.g., *walk, watch, study*). Negatives use **don't**.
- **He / She / It** → add **-s / -es / -ies** to the verb (e.g., *walks, watches, studies*). Negatives use **doesn't** + base form!
- **Keywords:** always, usually, often, sometimes, never, every day, on Mondays.
